### CHILDREN'S BURN CENTER VISITS YOUNG HORIZONS

This month, we had the incredible opportunity to host a presentation from the Children's Burn Center, focused on fire prevention and safety. Our preschoolers engaged in an interactive session that not only educated them about the dangers of fire but also empowered them to take safety seriously.

### THE IMPORTANCE OF OPEN HOUSES AT OUR CHILD CARE CENTERS

This fall, we held Open Houses at each of our centers. Open houses play a vital role in building a strong foundation for our childcare community. They provide a unique opportunity for families to connect with our staff as well as other parents. These personal interactions foster a sense of belonging and help create a supportive community, where families feel comfortable and valued. During open houses, parents explored their children's classroom where they learned about our curriculum and philosophy. This allows families to gain a deeper understanding of how we nurture each child's development, ensuring they feel confident in their choice of care and education. Children were encouraged to participate in hands-on activities with their parents, allowing them to experience the learning environment in a fun and relaxed setting.

Open houses are more than just events—they are essential for fostering relationships, building community, and ensuring that families feel informed and engaged. We are grateful for the opportunity to connect with our families.



#### **DENTAL AND VISION SCREENINGS**

Vision and dental health are critical components of overall childhood development. Early identification of vision problems can lead to timely interventions, ensuring that children can see clearly and perform well in school. Similarly, dental presentations help educate about oral health issues that, if left untreated, can lead to more serious problems later in life.

Recently, volunteers from the Long Beach Lions Club visited Young Horizons to conduct vision screenings for all our children. This service was offered free of charge through the Lions KidSight USA vision screening program. These trained volunteers used the Welch Allyn Spot Vision Screener to screen 245 of our children. The screening devices detect risk factors for strabismus (eyes that cross or wander out), refractive errors and unequal vision between the two eyes, and potentially even more serious issues such as cataracts and eye cancer.

The Lollipop Dental team visited all our centers and presented a comprehensive dental hygiene program. They taught the children proper brushing techniques, discussed which foods are good or bad for their teeth, and shared a story about teeth and dental care. The program also included a quick category game for the children and an opportunity to practice toothbrushing. Each child received a goodie bag containing a toothbrush, toothpaste, a sticker, and an oral hygiene brochure for parents.

These screenings not only serve individual children but also raise awareness within the community about the importance of regular health check-ups. By partnering with local health organizations, we can provide resources and support for families, encouraging them to prioritize their children's health as well as their own.
